## ESTABLISHMENT OF OFF-CAMPUS OF BASIC AND APPLIED SCIENCE RESEARCH CENTRE OF THE KLE UNIVERSITY AT KLE COLLEGE OF PHARMACY, BANGALORE

### PREAMBLE:

The Principal, KLE College of Pharmacy, Bangalore, a constituent unit of the KLE University, had requested the University seeking permission to set up **Off-campus Basic and Applied Science Research Centre** in the premises of the aforesaid Institution.

The University, while considering the proposal, noted that Dr. Subhash S.Karki, Professor of Pharmaceutical Chemistry, KLE College of Pharmacy, Bangalore has been actively engaged in quality research with financial support from Central Government Agencies, Indian Institute of Science and Pharmaceutical industry at Bangalore. The publications with excellent Impact Factor of more than 20 have been published by the aforesaid faculty member who has established good research laboratory.

The proposal was examined at length and taking into consideration the good scope for the research activities at Bangalore, the University has decided to establish Off-campus of Basic and Applied Science Research Centre of the KLE University at Bangalore after obtaining necessary approval from the competent authorities of the University.

### OBJECTIVE:

The objective of setting of this Research Centre in Bangalore is to facilitate collaborative research with well-known Institutions and industries located in and around Bangalore like Indian Institute of Science, Institute of Bioinformatics and Bio-technology, etc. mainly to encourage and motivate the teaching staff members, Ph.D. Research Scholars and Post-Graduate students for research activities, to attract funding from external funding agencies like DBT, CSIR, DST, ICMR, etc. and also to encourage research publications.

The matter was placed in the meetings of the Planning and Monitoring Board held on 17<sup>th</sup> May 2014, the Board of Management held on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2014 and the Academic Council of the University held on 9<sup>th</sup> June 2014. After detailed deliberations, the proposal for establishment of Off-campus of Basic and Applied Science Research Centre of the University in the premises of KLE College of Pharmacy, Bangalore was approved by the competent authorities of the University. It was also decided that the proposed Research Centre shall work under the overall guidance of KLE Dr. Prabhakar Kore Basic and Applied Science Research Centre, Belgaum.



## FINANCIAL SUPPORT FROM THE UNIVERSITY:

Out of the budget provision made for the Research activities for the financial year 2014-15, the University intends to allocate a budget of Rs.30.00 lakhs (to be utilized for the remaining period of nine months of the current financial year i.e. from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2014 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2015) for the Basic and Applied Science Research Centre (Off-campus) at Bangalore towards development of infrastructure, grant of scholarships to the Ph.D. Research Scholars, incentive for the faculty members for research publications and industry-institute interaction cell activities.

The break-up details of the budgetary provision made are as follows which is to be utilized with prior approval from the University, in accordance with the existing Rules and Regulations of the University:



The Director, KLE University Research Foundation shall give his valuable suggestions / inputs aimed at research excellence.
